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Vinegars of the World

Vinegars can be considered as acidic products of special importance for the enrichment of our diet, and resulting from the desired or controlled oxidation of ethanol containing (liquid) substrates. The traditional use and integration of vinegars in numerous cultures can be traced back to ancient times. In fact, the cultural heritage of virtually every civilization includes one or more vinegars made by the souring action (of micro-organisms) following alcoholic fermentation. It has been documented that the Egyptians, Sumerians and Babylonians had experience and technical knowledge in making vinegar from barley and any kind of fruit. Vinegar was very popular both in ancient Greece and Rome, where it was used in food preparations and as remedy against a great number of diseases. In Asia, the first records about vinegar date back to the Zhou Dynasty (1027-221 BC) and probably China's ancient rice wines may have originally been derived from fruit, for which (malted) rice was substituted later. The historical and geographical success of vinegars is mainly due to the low technology required for their production, and to the fact that several kinds of raw materials rich in sugars may easily be processed to give vinegar. In addition, vinegars are well-known and accepted as safe and stable commodities that can be consumed as beverages, health drinks or added to food as preservatives or as flavoring agents.

Once upon a time, one of the greatest mischievous activities which I and my brother loved to indulge in was appreciating the homemade orange wine or any other fruit wine made by my father for home consumption, and then smacking our lips, and saying, “Excellent orange vinegar, you have made again dad, where did you go wrong now?” Of course, the wine was excellent, but it would have him hurrying for a glass of his own, and then wondering what he had done to deserve

to such philistines who could not appreciate the difference between good wine and good vinegar. And we would always console him that it would do very well when he was cooking chicken or whatever in a casserole. Seriously speaking, I can recognize drunk vinegar better than drunk wine, today. In our city's French Institute, they have annual wine and cheese sessions, I was always asked to take the first sip of the open bottle to see whether it was fit for consumption. If I looked at the ceiling pensively, and then wondered whether it was wine I was drinking, the bottle would be finished immediately. But the moment I said "oh wow, what is this stuff", – only those desperate enough to finish the bottles would drink from that particular bottle. It took me 3 years to find out that I was the official vinegar tester! Naturally, in ancient times, vinegar, which has a large percentage of acetic acid, was not only used for healing and for beauty purposes, but it was also used to give dishes a sour taste.

Vinegars and Catsup

Excerpt from *Vinegars and Catsup: Interpretation of Standards, Analysis, Etc* Vinegar is essentially a dilute solution of acetic acid, but it must be remembered that it is the product of a definite fermentation, containing appreciable quantities of certain solid and liquid substances derived from the material thus fermented, and that a solution of acetic acid (as purchased in the chemical market) reduced to proper strength can only be considered as an imitation spirit vinegar, at the best. And as an imitation of a good spirit vinegar it would be a very poor makeshift. The constituents other than acetic acid which are present, as well as the characteristic flavor, etc., of a true vinegar depend, of course, upon the nature of the material-which has been fermented into vinegar. The four principal vinegars in use at present are: Wine vinegar, resulting from the alcoholic and subsequent acetous fermentations of grape juice; cider vinegar from properly fermented pure apple cider; maltvinegar from the alcoholic and subsequent acetous fermentation of an undistilled infusion of barley malt or cereals whose starch has been converted by malt. In some countries a certain vinegar is often so extensively used, or was so exclusively used originally, as to restrict the simple term, vinegar, to that particular variety, as, for example, malt vinegar in England, or wine vinegar in Continental Europe. In the United States the only vinegar known for years was cider vinegar, and among food inspection authorities it has always been customary to hold that when the consumer simply asks for vinegar, cider vinegar is called for and

should be furnished by the dealer. Thus the Federal food standards (circular 19, Office of Secretary, U. S. Department of Agriculture) restricts the single term vinegar to indicate cider vinegar. Flavor is an important evaluation indicator of beverage quality and has a significant impact on product quality ratings and consumer preferences. The variety and content of volatile and non-volatile compounds are the main reasons for flavor differences in beverages, while the type of raw materials and processing methods will affect the final flavors of the products. There are many kinds of beverages with a complex aroma and taste components. Accurate analysis of such volatile and non-volatile sensory substances is the key to studying their gustatory characteristic. There are hundreds of volatile components in beverages, mainly including aldehydes, ketones, alcohols, acids, and sulfur-containing compounds. In order to systematically study the chemical nature of the inherent aroma of beverages and their flavor formation mechanisms, it is necessary to focus on revealing the metabolic pathways of the key aroma substances at the molecular level. Additionally, it is important to explore the interactions between beverage matrices and aromas, as well as the elimination mechanisms for off-flavor formations. It is proposed that the combination of modern instrumental analysis with molecular sensory science, and in-depth discussions of the aroma formation pathways and aroma release mechanisms in beverages is a major focus of future aroma research.
