Opéra-comique, like grand opéra, a specifically French genre of opera, emerged from the political changes and intellectual discussion that played a recurrent role in determining the nature of artistic expression and production in Paris from the late 17th until the mid-18th centuries. Opéra-comique is distinguished by its use of spoken dialogue to link the arias and sung parts, and its more restrained use of recitatives. It emerged out of the popular entertainments, called opéras-comiques en vaudevilles, that were a feature of the theatres held at the seasonal Parisian fairs of St Germain and St Laurent, and of the Comédie-Italienne. The similarity of the entertainments provided by the Comédie-Italienne and the fairs resulted in their amalgamation on 3 February 1756, when they established a theatre for their joint productions, the Hôtel Bourgogne. Their type of entertainment, combining existing popular tunes with spoken sections, lent its generic name to this house, which, regardless of its changing venue, would become known as the Opéra-Comique. The genre of opéra-comique exercised a powerful popular appeal because of its unique fusion of fixed musical form with fluid improvised dialogue. The well-known airs of the day, invariably strophic, came to be the genre's staple medium of artistic expression—the couplets. But opéra-comique was not necessarily comic or light in nature. Indeed, the most famous example, Bizet's *Carmen* (1875), is a tragedy. The genre, with its unique mixture of comedy and drama, its captivating musical fluency, its handling of serious and Romantic themes—expertly crafted by its most famous librettist Augustin-Eugène Scribe (1791-1861)—became universally popular in the masterpieces of its heyday between 1820 and 1870: Adrien Boieldieu's *La Dame blanche* (1825), Daniel-François-Esprit Auber's *Fra Diavolo* (1830) and *Le Domino noir* (1837), Ferdinand Hérold's *Zampa* (1831) and *Le Pré aux clercs* (1832), Fromental Halévy's *L'Éclair* (1835) and Ambroise Thomas's *Mignon* (1866). The history of the opéra-comique between 1762 and 1915 reflects the political and cultural life of France—from the last days of the ancien régime, through the tumult of the Revolution and Napoleonic era, the July Monarchy and Second Empire, to the shattering defeat of France by Prussia in 1870. After this, apart from isolated works (by Bizet, Delibes, Offenbach, Massenet), new works by the younger generation of musicians now tended to be French adaptations of the Wagnerian aesthetic and the record of success is very thin. Hardly any native French works in this imitative mode premiered at the Opéra-Comique between 1870 and 1915 have survived—apart from Debussy's unique *Pelléas et Mélisande* (1902). This study serves as a sourcebook for this very French genre, with details of forgotten composers, their operas—performance dates, plot summaries, the singers who created them, the names of important numbers in the works (from libretti and scores that are either now to be found only in the Paris libraries, or are lost completely), often with contemporary observations about the reception of particular works, the effectiveness of their dramaturgy and music. It provides a resource for operatic culture and convention, from the late 18th to the early 20th centuries. The record of the fortunes of the Opéra-Comique provides a way into the changing culture and aesthetic values of an age.

When America began to emerge as a world power at the end of the nineteenth century, Italy was a young nation, recently unified. The technological advances brought about by electricity and the combustion engine were vastly speeding up the capacity of news, ideas, and artefacts to travel internationally. Furthermore, improved literacy and social reforms had produced an Italian working class with increased time, money, and education. At the turn of the century, if Italy's ruling elite continued the tradition of viewing Paris as a model of sophistication and good taste, millions of lowly-educated Italians began to dream of America, and many bought a transatlantic ticket to migrate there. By the 1920s, Italians were encountering America through Hollywood films and, thanks to illustrated magazines, they were mesmerised by the sight of Manhattan's futuristic skyline and by news of American lifestyle. The USA offered a model of modernity which flouted national borders and spoke to all. It could be snubbed, adored, or transformed for one's personal use, but it could not be ignored. Perversely, Italy was by then in the hands of a totalitarian dictatorship, Mussolini's Fascism. Tosca is an opera in three acts by Giacomo Puccini to an Italian libretto by Luigi Illica and Giuseppe Giacosa. It premiered at the Teatro Costanzi in Rome on 14 January 1900. The work, based on Victorien Sardou's 1887 French-language dramatic play, *La Tosca*, is a melodramatic piece set in Rome in June 1800, with the Kingdom of Naples's control of Rome threatened by Napoleon's invasion of Italy. It contains depictions of torture, murder and suicide, yet also includes some of Puccini's best-known lyrical arias, and has inspired memorable performances from many of opera's leading singers.

PREHISTORY

The Grail knight Gurnemanz is at the forest lake not far from the castle.

The squires ask who the mysterious woman is. Gurnemanz answers that she is a cursed woman who is expiating a debt. Half-dead, she was found in the forest at the time when the terrible thing happened to Amfortas.

He tells the squires the story of Amfortas's wound, which has tormented him for years and has not closed since. The spear lies unreachable at Klingsor.

In prayer, a voice had appeared to Amfortas, prophesying that only a pure fool, knowing through pity, could succeed in recovering the spear.

Now a man appears with a dead swan in his hand, which he had shot from the sky with his bow.

Gurnemanz admonishes him that hunting is forbidden here.

Gurnemanz then invites the young man to the castle in the hope of meeting the fool who will one day bring back Klingsor's spear

In the hall of Montsalvat, Parsifal witnesses the communion ritual to which Gurnemanz invites him in order to win Parsifal over for their cause. Solemnly the knights march up. Finally, Amfortas is carried in.

The bowl is ceremoniously unveiled. A ray of light penetrates from above and the bowl shines in a brilliant purple color. Amfortas blesses the bread and wine.

The knights take communion. Amfortas then leaves the hall followed by the knights. Gurnemanz and Parsifal remain behind.

In Klingsor's magic castle.

Parsifal approaches the castle on his way from Montsalvat and Klingsor orders Kundry to seduce him, as she once did with Amfortas.

Kundry enters this scene in transformed form as a young woman. She calls him Parsifal and thus reveals his true name.

Kundry sees the hopelessness of her action and calls Klingsor for help. He appears with the spear and hurls it at Parsifal's head.

The castle sinks and the garden in withered to a wasteland. Parsifal looks at Kundry, who has collapsed, and calls out to her that she knows where to find him.

In the area of Montsalvat, it is spring

Gurnemanz hears a groan. He discovers Kundry lying half frozen on the ground. She is dressed in her penitential robe; when Gurnemanz wakes her up, she seems transformed.

Parsifal, for his part, tells him of his years-long, rocky Journey in search of Montsalvat, Exhausted, Parsifal collapses.

He then anoints Parsifal's head and welcomes him as Amfortas' successor.

Parsifal, for his part, turns to Kundry and performs the baptism to release her from her torment and

suit.

Now the three proceed to the castle. Parsifal carries the spear solemnly before him.

In the great hall the aged Amfortas is before the shrine. Painfully he feels the guilt of his father's death because he never revealed the Grail. The knights implore him to reveal the life-giving Grail.

Parsifal performs the ritual and the Grail glows again.
