The Western Graphite Mine was worked in the 1930s by the Western Graphite Company.

The graphite here occurs as flakes and masses in graphite amphibole schist.

The Western Graphite Co.'s 50-ton flotation mill processed graphite ore from 1934 to 1935.

The deposit was called the Black Diamond deposit.

The graphite venture was abandoned in 1935. The mill was then converted to a custom gold mill that tested ores from as far away as Lone Pine.

I originally thought the Black Diamond and Western Graphite were different mines, but I recently discovered that they were actually the same mine.

This adit was dug along the same deposit as the other workings. They are about a mile and a half away!

Lets go check out this unnamed mine that I spotted from the road!
