The validation exercise ensures critical variability is identified and controls to meet the drug product Critical Quality Attributes (CQA's).

Focusing exclusively on qualification efforts

without also understanding the manufacturing process

and associated variations may not lead to adequate assurance of quality.

An integrated team approach should be used analytical chemistry, manufacturing, and quality assurance. Process Design is where knowledge gained through development and scale-up activities is used to define the commercial manufacturing process. The CQA's and Critical Process Parameters (CPP's) are defined. The risk assessments gauge the level of process understanding, robustness, and control. Guidance for Industry Process Qualification phase can be broken into two parts. Process Validation: General combines the facility, utilities, equipment, operators, procedures and raw materials with the commercial manufacturing process.
