Globalization refers to the integration of the national market to a wider global markets signified by the increase in free trade.

WHAT IS INTERNATIONAL TRADING CENTER?

Globalization is when all important populated continents begin to exchange product continuously-both with each other directly and indirectly via other continents creating an impact on its trading partners. Galleon trade is an example of International Trading in the Mercantilism era. Some monarch impose impossible tariffs to limit trade and maximize income.

In 1867, through the joint effort of Europe, America and other countries, they adopted the gold standard later known as monetary reserves in order to defend their products from high tariffs. It is all based on the value of gold.

Countries involved in the war had to deplete their gold reserves in order to fund their armies and many were forced to abandon the gold standard.

The world returned to the gold standard in early 20th Century. Today, the world economy operates on what is called fiat currencies - currencies that are not backed by precious metals whose value is determined by their cost relative to other currencies. It is determined by supply and demand in the world market.

John Maynard Keynes states that when economies slow down, governments have to reinvigorate markets with infusions of capital. It was called global Keynesianism.

Bretton Wood System stimulated the creation of financial institutions such as International Bank for Reconstruction and Development IBRD or World Bank for post war reconstruction. The second one was the International Monetary Fund IMF, which was to be the global lender.

Neoliberalism and its Discontents

The height of Global Keynesianism came in the 1940's to the early 1970's. During this time governments poured money in their economies. The world accepted the law of supply and demand.

However in the 1970's the price of oil rose sharply.

Which continent is the major supplier of oil?

When USA and other countries decided to resupply oil to Israeli Military, the Middle East imposed an embargo. This affected Western Countries that were reliant on oil.

Washington consensus dominated the global economic policies from 1980s to 2000s. It advocates minimal government spending to reduce government debt. It also called for privatization of services such as water, power, communication and transport

It was declared that along the way, some industries would be affected and eventually die but they considered it "shock therapy" necessary for long-term economic growth. It was a success for Reagan and Thatcher.

What form of government does Russia have?

US removed banking and investment restrictions in 1980s. Neoliberalism came under strain during the global financial crisis of 2007-2008. Taking advantage of "cheap housing loans" Americans began building houses that were beyond their financial capacity.

What do you think happened?

Increasing supply caught up with the demand. It became a crisis. Invested banks like Lehman Brothers depleted major investments and created a ripple effect since most investors were foreigners. Iceland was heavily dependent on foreign investors so when foreign investors could no longer invest, Iceland accumulated debt. It affected the healthcare system, pensions, and other forms of social security.
