Ignatius von Loyola

These Spiritual Exercises were written by Ignatius of Loyola, a theologian, priest and founder of the Society of Jesus, in the sixteenth century. They are Catholic prayers, reflections, meditations, mental exercises and directions designed to be read and carried out over a 28 to 30 day time period. These exercises are for Catholics and non-Catholics alike and grew out of Ignatius' own desire to seek God's will and to follow Christ no matter what the cost. Ignatius' intent was that the exercises would help others to discern God's will and to set the world on fire for Christ!

Ignatius von Loyola

The founder of the Jesuit order, Ignatius of Loyola, wrote a type of testaments for Catholics: *Spiritual Exercises* - a collection of Christian prayers and meditations that encourage reflection on God. The book serves as a practical manual: presenting a schedule of prayers, tests of conscience, prayers, and contemplative exercises for 30 days. Today, these practices serve not only Catholics but any person seeking to improve the state of one's spirit. Just as daily exercise improves the body of any person, so the daily spiritual exercises outlined by Ignatius of Loyola provide any dedicated person, whether he claims religion or not, with the tools needed to calm and expand their soul. However, despite their universality, it should be emphasized that *Spiritual Exercises* are based on Catholic dogma.

Zunächst soll die Gründungsfigur des heiligen Ignatius von Loyola im Hinblick auf ihr Leben vor der Bekehrung bei Pamplona näher beleuchtet werden. In einem weiteren Kapitel soll analysiert werden, wie der in Pamplona begonnene Prozess der Bekehrung vonstatten gegangen ist und ein Blick auf den Bericht des Pilgers, eine Reisebeschreibung des Gründers der Jesuiten, die die Zeit von seiner Verwundung bei Pamplona bis hin zu Ignatius Aufenthalt in Rom umfasst, geworfen werden. Dieser Ausschnitt aus der Biographie des Ignatius soll, gewissermaßen als Vorgeschichte zur eigentlichen Errichtung des Jesuitenordens, darstellen, inwiefern die Ereignisse im Leben des Heiligen vor seiner Bekehrung, vor allem aber seit seiner Verwundung bei Pamplona, ihn zur Gründung eines Ordens veranlasst und geprägt haben. Ferner soll ein genauer Blick auf die Gefährten des hl. Ignatius und die Umstände, die zum Beschluss der Gründung einer Ordensgemeinschaft führten, erfolgen.

Ein weiteres Kapitel soll schließlich auf die Ausarbeitung der Ordensregel und der Satzungen der Gesellschaft Jesu, sowie die Bestätigung durch den Heiligen Stuhl näher eingehen.
