Le Sénégal, une démocratie du phénix ?

Au Sénégal, le système électoral est confronté à deux obstacles permanents : le rôle prépondérant du parti au pouvoir dans la définition des règles du jeu et dans l'arbitrage du verdict des urnes ; le poids des logiques sociales et des représentations symboliques qui influencent le vote. L'alternance de mars 2000 était porteuse d'une révolution des mœurs politiques, d'une consolidation de la démocratie et d'un renforcement des institutions de la République. Mais les espoirs de changement ont été déçus. Serait-ce parce que le Sénégal n'est qu'une "démocratie sans démocrates" ? La réalité, plus complexe, peut être décrite avec la métaphore du phénix qui renaît de ses cendres. Le pouvoir d'Etat repose dans ce pays sur des forces sociales enracinées et élabore sa légitimation sur la base de représentations monarchiques du pouvoir. Alioune Badara Diop le démontre en proposant une sociologie électorale

du Fouta Tooro où la domination politique de l'oligarchie toorodo pèse sur le vote, en perpétuant les logiques sociales qui l'ont toujours déterminé. Cet ouvrage constitue un outil indispensable à la compréhension des mutations sociales et politiques du Sénégal contemporain.

Arboretum et fruticetum Britannicum; or, The trees and shrubs of Britain ... pictorically and botanically delineated, and scientifically and popularly described ...

Paul Signac and Color in Neo-Impressionism is a groundbreaking examination of the artistic technique of "divisionism" in terms of modern scientific theory of color. Truly interdisciplinary in his approach, Floyd Ratliff treats the evolution of both color theory and artistic practice in an integrated way. Signac was the principal advocate for the new movement launched by Georges Seurat in the 1880s. The book is handsomely illustrated with both Neo-Impressionist paintings and scientific drawings and diagrams. Ratliff's five-part essay provides an extended introduction to a translation of Signac's monograph, *From Eugene Delacroix to Neo-Impressionism*, widely regarded as the basic document of the movement, but never before available in English. This will be an invaluable reference for scholars in art and design, as well as students of the psychology and neurophysiology of color vision and those interested in the

relation between the arts and the sciences. Its clarity of style also makes it accessible to the general reader interested in art history, painting, or the perception of color, particularly with its glossary of technical and art terms, index, and bibliography.

The chaotic state of fornication, mating, and birthing may be a throwback to the past.

Maria Callas was, perhaps, the greatest opera singer of the 20th century. Hers was a life lived on the world stage, and her fame extended to the public consciousness of many parts of the world. Even after her mysterious death in 1977, her singing and acting continue to thrill new generations of opera fans thanks to her many recordings and her fascinating life. This new biography of Callas tells her story from difficult beginnings as the daughter of Greek immigrants to New York City in 1923 to her wonderful performances at La Scala, Covent Garden, and the Metropolitan Opera. Callas was quite a diva and a master at creating a captivating public image. She also became notorious because of her very public affair with Aristotle Onassis, the wealthy ship-owner who left Callas to marry Jacqueline Kennedy.

Robert Lehman (1891-1969), one of the foremost art collectors of his generation, embraced the work of both traditional and modern masters. This volume catalogues 130 nineteenth- and twentieth-century paintings that are now part of the Robert Lehman Collection at The Metropolitan Museum of Art. The majority of the works are by artists based in France, but there are also examples from the United States, Latin America, and India, reflecting Lehman's global interests. The catalogue opens with outstanding paintings by Ingres, Théodore Rousseau, and Corot, among other early nineteenth-century artists. They are joined by an exemplary selection of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist works by Degas, Renoir, Sisley, Pissarro, Seurat, Signac, Van Gogh, Cézanne, and Gauguin. Twentieth-century masters represented here include Bonnard, Matisse, Rouault, Dalí, and Balthus. There are also newly researched modern works by Vicente do Rego Monteiro, Kees van Dongen, Dietz Edzard, and D.G. Kulkarni (dizi). Robert Lehman's cultivated taste for nineteenth-century French academic practitioners and his intuitive eye for emerging young artists of his own time are documented and discussed. Three hundred comparative illustrations supplement the catalogue entries, as do extensively researched provenance information, exhibition histories, and references. The volume also includes a bibliography and indexes.

Pero san Agustín nos lleva a una nueva concepción de la fe y la ortodoxia cristianas que Paul Ricoeur denominaría identidad *ipse*, en la que está implicada la actuación o mediación del sujeto. A la luz de san Agustín, el artículo sostiene que la ortodoxia no debería definirse como aquello que asegura las fronteras mediante la exclusión, sino que, más bien, tendría que definirse a partir del centro de la fe cristiana, que es el amor. Las afirmaciones de ortodoxia, en suma, tienen que derivarse de la interpretación del amor y de su práctica.

¿Qué es realmente la Iglesia? Esta nueva edición revisada y actualizada de "Para comprender la eclesiología desde América Latina" trata de dar respuesta a esta pregunta ya en pleno siglo XXI. No es propiamente «otro» libro, porque sigue fundamentalmente la estructura, el desarrollo temático y la metodología del libro anterior. Pero sí que es un libro realmente «nuevo», no sólo porque trata nuevas cuestiones, sino también porque los temas tradicionales se ven con una nueva luz y desde una nueva perspectiva. El libro anterior estaba escrito en la perspectiva de los 500 años de la primera evangelización, y resumaba el entusiasmo del cristianismo liberador que se respiraba en América Latina en las décadas de 1970 y 1980: el impulso de Medellín, las comunidades de base, los grandes obispos defensores de los pobres... Ahora, ante un nuevo contexto, surgen nuevas preguntas, que bien podrían resumirse en una sola: ¿Cómo ser cristianos y cristianas desde América Latina hoy, en los albores del tercer milenio?

2as Conversaciones de Cala Figuera

El autor de esta obra aborda el problema del sida desde su propio contexto nigeriano, confrontando únicamente con la realidad vivida de tantos amigos y parientes a los que la enfermedad se ha llevado consigo. Lo aborda como igbo y como teólogo, en diálogo con la modernidad y con el mundo occidental, pero con la esperanza siempre presente de que también su pueblo, desde valores y convicciones más profundas, tienen la capacidad y los medios necesarios para que el sida, con una original propuesta de prevención, se convierta en una nueva mirada de vida y esperanza.

Exultación expositiva

Se inserta el cambio identitario de la Compañía de Jesús en el contexto de las transformaciones del catolicismo en la Modernidad. Una vez que surge la corriente del Romanticismo entre los pensadores católicos, la Iglesia católica empieza a apropiarse de ese discurso frente a los desafíos de la Modernidad. Así es como el tradicional ultramontanismo se vuelve un ultramontanismo romántico y antimoderno. La Compañía de Jesús se restaura en la misma época en que acontece esta romantización del ultramontanismo. Los jesuitas empiezan a generar un discurso compatible con el romanticismo, pues se consideran víctimas que fueron suprimidas por enemigos del cristianismo. Es así como la Compañía de Jesús en la Modernidad redefine su identidad con base en una nueva autoridad: la del Soberano Pontífice. El libro estudia cómo es que la Antigua Compañía de Jesús tenía una autoridad distinta, y por ende su identidad no era la misma que la de la Nueva Compañía. Estos cambios sucedieron en Europa, pero eventualmente llegaron a México, aunque tardíamente. Los jesuitas en la Nueva España, antes de la expulsión de 1767, tenían un papel mucho más importante que en Europa al dominar en la educación y al organizar la vida social en las misiones del Norte. Dejaron un gran vacío hasta que regresaron en 1816, y pronto reanudaron sus importantes labores. No obstante, fueron nuevamente suprimidos. Así continuaron hasta el Porfiriato, cuando se estabilizó la presencia de jesuitas. Pero estos jesuitas no eran los antiguos jesuitas de tradición hispánica, sino que eran ya jesuitas romantizados como en Europa. Esto explica por qué, casi repentinamente, a partir de la década de 1880, los jesuitas empiezan a encabezar la forma embrionaria de la "Acción Católica". Esta actividad cobrará la misma forma politizada y beligerante que tenía en Europa sólo cuando aparezca la Revolución anticlerical a México: la Revolución Mexicana y su eventual prolongación en las Guerras Cristeras. La autoridad y la identidad de los jesuitas tendrán su apogeo precisamente en estos acontecimientos. Sin embargo, en Europa la circunstancia era ya diferente: la noción decimonónica de la autoridad comienza a desgastarse, y el síntoma más evidente de ello fue el surgimiento de los Fascismos. Lo mismo sucede con la legitimidad que tenía el Romano Pontífice y en particular la autoridad del Prepósito General de la Compañía de Jesús. Es el momento en que la autoridad

se vuelve un autoritarismo. Esto tiene sus repercusiones en la Compañía de Jesús porque, como la autoridad condicionaba su identidad, ésta se ve también desgastada. Este libro recorre la historia desde que surgen una nueva autoridad y una nueva identidad de la Compañía de Jesús -en 1814- hasta que comienza su final -en 1929-.

Identidad y ciudadanía

Políticas de Igualdad desde Latinoamérica: transformación hacia sociedades en los cuidados es un texto que expone las desigualdades en la vida cotidiana de la familia y el trabajo, las diferencias entre los géneros, en el contexto de un sistema capitalista que se resiste a reconocer la subordinación del trabajo remunerado y no remunerado, entre los géneros, y que debe abrir el debate profundo de la importancia de los cuidados con el afán de dar respuesta a un vacío histórico que no se ha logrado explicar, por qué los cuidados siguen siendo mayoritariamente solo un asunto de las mujeres. ¿Quién cuida a quién? es un gran interrogante. En la actualidad, los cuidados involucran a todos los sectores de la sociedad que se articulan entre lo político, lo económico, la salud y lo social en los diferentes ciclos de vida del ser humano. ¿Qué sucede si el gasto social de los cuidados es incosteable para el Estado, las empresas y las organizaciones sindicales de trabajadores? ¿Qué sucede si disminuyen o desaparecen los apoyos sociales de los cuidados? Es necesario pues una propuesta de análisis sobre las políticas de igualdad de género y los cuidados como la que aquí se presenta, que se realizan desde las ciencias sociales, con un enfoque pluridisciplinar que incluye la economía, la sociología, la antropología, el derecho o la geografía. El objetivo central es que estos análisis y reflexiones de las políticas públicas en materia de igualdad que se han implementado en los distintos países latinoamericanos puedan contribuir en las políticas públicas en todo el mundo.

Relations Between Cultures

The conversion of Spanish Roma to Pentecostal Evangelical Protestantism is one of the most unknown yet important modern religious movements. Its current spectacular transnational growth is due, among others factors, to the fact that it is directed, organized, and composed of Gypsies. This book provides one of the first serious analyses of an important historical, theological, and ethnographic account of the Pentecostal Revival movement that has been sweeping through the Southern European Roma/Gypsy.

América Latina y la doctrina social de la Iglesia: Identidad cultural y modernización

Este libro parte de las ideas que centraron el trabajo académico de Richard A. Schoenherr. Su investigación examinó cuestiones de sociología de la religión y se centró en los efectos del cambio en la organización de la Iglesia Católica. Utilizando técnicas demográficas, documentó el porcentaje de hombres que se salían del sacerdocio y demostró los efectos de esta salida sobre la jerarquía y el laicado. Estaba convencido de que no se habían evaluado las implicaciones de este importante cambio social y consideró que su misión era alertar a la Iglesia de la necesidad de adaptarse a un clero radicalmente reducido y a un laicado que deseaba compartir el ministerio de la iglesia. Su idea desvela la estrecha vinculación organizativa del celibato obligatorio a la estructura central del poder eclesiástico. Éste será el principal hilo conductor de su trabajo hasta su obra póstuma. Para Schoenherr, lo que parece una controversia interna de los católicos es, en realidad, una batalla sobre el patriarcado en la sociedad general y, en definitiva, un planteamiento original del debate clásico sobre la interacción entre religión y cambio social.

Ortodoxia e ideología. La ambigüedad y el potencial de reivindicar la ortodoxia. Concilium 355 (2014)

Está creciendo el interés, la conciencia y la demanda por el conocimiento de que la justicia social es algo que sale de la fe cristiana. Pero esto no es algo nuevo. Por quinientos años la cultura e identidad latina han sido moldeadas por sus desafíos al statu quo religioso, socioeconómico y político, ya sea en oposición al colonialismo español, las dictaduras latinoamericanas, el imperialismo estadounidense en Centro América, la opresión de los trabajadores de campo o la explotación actual de inmigrantes indocumentados. El cristianismo ha jugado un papel significativo en ese movimiento en cada etapa. Robert Chao Romero, hijo de padre mexicano y madre inmigrante china, explora la historia y la teología de lo que él llama la «iglesia mestiza». Romero considera como este movimiento ha respondido a estas y otras injusticias a lo largo de su historia al apelar a la creencia que la visión de Dios por la redención incluye no solo promesas celestiales sino también la transformación de cada aspecto de nuestras vidas y el mundo. Al recorrer esta historia de activismo y fe, lectores descubrirán que los cristianos latinos tienen un corazón conforme al de Dios.

Iglesia peruana

La vida religiosa está enfrentada a una profunda crisis que no es coyuntural sino estructural; su modelo actual se ha quedado obsoleto y resulta inviable. La presente obra aboga por un cambio de modelo de la vida religiosa, para responder a los nuevos retos que se plantean en sociedades de cristiandad que han dejado de serlo. Se parte de una revisión de la base exegética, histórica y espiritual sobre la que se ha asentado el modelo teológico tradicional de los religiosos. A la luz de la evolución teológica hay que cuestionar algunos de los tópicos fundamentales sobre los que se ha construido teológica e históricamente el monacato, en un primer momento, y los modelos posteriores medievales, de la Contrarreforma, modernos y contemporáneos. En este marco hay que referirse también a la complementariedad de la vida contemplativa y activa, así como al papel de los institutos seculares y las asociaciones laicales que se diferencian de los religiosos desde un proyecto evangélico radical. Pero este estudio va más allá y, centrándose en la situación actual, quiere ayudar a la renovación de los religiosos desde la perspectiva de los laicos. La teología actual de laicado puede ofrecer muchas contribuciones para una redefinición de la vida religiosa y sus tareas. Si en el pasado se dio una monaquización del laicado, hoy es este último el que puede aportar nuevos horizontes a los religiosos. Se busca así desarrollar una eclesiología de comunión y una nueva misión cristiana en el contexto de la globalización, la secularización y la postmodernidad.

Para comprender la eclesiología desde América Latina

La ortodoxia puede aparentemente resultar algo inocente, puesto que su preocupación es mantener la verdad y la validez de las propias creencias religiosas. Sin embargo, la historia y la experiencia han mostrado que ha sido un concepto ideológicamente cargado que ha servido como medio de exclusión, como punto de referencia para reprimir la libertad de pensamiento y como arma para «disciplinar y castigar». No diferente ha sido el caso de la ortodoxia cristiana.

La Fe en la historia y la sociedad

Cuarenta años después del Vaticano II, el cristianismo se encuentra enfrentado a una profunda crisis, sobre todo en los países del Primer Mundo. ¿En qué ha quedado el legado del Concilio y cuáles son las causas conciliares de la crisis posterior? ¿Qué factores han intervenido en la época postconciliar que han llevado a la situación actual? ¿Se puede hablar del Vaticano II como una oportunidad histórica fallida? Éstas son algunas de las preguntas a las que pretende responder este estudio. Pero no se trata sólo de causas internas del catolicismo, ya que hay nuevos factores que han propiciado la pérdida de relevancia del cristianismo en las sociedades desarrolladas. La secularización de la sociedad y la laicidad del Estado, juntamente con la crisis de la modernidad y la aparición de una cultura postmoderna, así como la globalización y la tercera revolución industrial han creado un nuevo contexto histórico. Las iglesias tienen dificultades para ubicarse en la sociedad ya que se ha roto la sintonía entre el modelo eclesial y el sociocultural. Hay un desfase institucional, teológico y organizativo, para responder a las nuevas demandas de las sociedades post-cristianas existentes en Europa. El autor analiza los problemas e intenta ofrecer algunas líneas de actuación: El protagonismo sociocultural de un laicado mayor de edad, lo cual exige la reforma interna y externa de la Iglesia; el replanteamiento de la institución eclesiástica para adecuarla a las nuevas necesidades pastorales; la vuelta a una eclesiología de comunión en el contexto del diálogo intracatólico, ecuménico y con las grandes religiones mundiales; una nueva espiritualidad que posibilite la experiencia de Dios en una sociedad secular, etcétera.

Sida en África

One can often encounter an opinion that Polish scientific (or analytic) philosophy (or the Lvov-Warsaw School) deserves to be much better known than actually is. This book is thought as a response to such a claim. The papers collected in this volume are divided into two parts: Background and Influence and History and Systematics. However, there is no sharp borderline between themes which are touched in both parts. Generally speaking, all papers of the first part relate the Lvov-Warsaw School to some philosophical movements (Brentanism, phenomenology and Marxism) external to it whereas the papers collected in the second one focus on internal issues connected with the school (only Roberto Poli takes into account Brentano's views in his discussion of reism). Since the Polish school of mathematical logic is much better known than the Polish analytic philosophy we decided to omit here any treatment of the former. Thus, this collection centers on purely philosophical matters. We projected this volume not as an exhaustive panorama of Polish analytic philosophy but rather as a series of essays on particular persons or topic. As a result one can find here papers on Twardowski, Ajdukiewicz, Kotarbinski, Tarski and Lukasiewicz as well as on ethics on science, nominalism, and the methodology of psychology. We hope that this book will contribute to a better knowledge and evaluation of Polish achievements in analytic philosophy. We would like to express our gratitude to Professor Leszek Nowak, the editor-in-chief of Poznan Studies in the Philosophy of the Sciences and the Humanities, who initiated the idea of the collection and helped in its preparation.
