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Healthy Eating and Pollution Protection for Kids

This easy-to-read guide on how to feed children healthy food is written for parents, teachers and also children who are studying this subject at school. Included is information on the dangers of feeding children junk food and how to avoid the clever advertising tricks that aim to attract youngsters to unhealthy eating practices. The Food Talk

It is every caregiver's responsibility to teach their kids about healthy eating,"€,"the earlier the better. But nutrition has so many gray areas and changing rules that it can be very complicated for kids to figure out on their own. Even we as adults get confused. For example, eating pizza once every couple of weeks may be fine but eating it every day is not. Where do you draw the line? Once a week? Every five days? Every nine days? Most parents want to give their children a head start in life, but they too often neglect the most important area—nutrition.
