Why Are Mental illnesses Stigmatized? • Mental illnesses associated with symptoms that the average person hasn't experienced are more stigmatized (fear of differences) • People are fascinated by stories of mental illnesses and violence • Belief that people with mental illnesses are

People drop out of psychiatric services in part, because they do not want to be known as using mental health services . Stigma leads to social withdrawal, thus depriving people with mental illnesses of the helpful connections and supports • Community attitudes may negatively influence recovery rates

Consequences of Stigma for Society • Discrimination contributes to the very low levels of employment

for people diagnosed with serious mental illnesses • Discrimination contributes to higher rates of homelessness • Limited mental health services in most states • Insurers create barriers to access mental health services

Stigma and discrimination are major reasons why college students do not see help at college health centers • Students are often uneducated about the signs and prevalence of mental health problems in young adults

While it's clear that there isn't a single gene that causes depression, data do suggest that there are genetic factors, likely a combination of genetics that affects brain function.

In a study of cab drivers in London, MRI scans revealed that when compared to controls, there were structural differences in their hippocampus (a part of the brain known to deal with spatial learning and memory).

Medications commonly prescribed for depression inhibit the reuptake of dopamine and serotonin, and have also been shown to affect the expression of neurotrophins.

We can't experiment on live human brains in the lab, so outside of tools like MRI we often have to rely on animal models, and it's really hard to study something like depression in rodents.

We have tests to represent "depression-like behaviors" in non-human animals, but there are big questions about whether those tests are really getting at the human experience.
