Treatment for early stage cancer can require a hysterectomy. or removal of the uterus and cervix, after which pregnancy is no longer possible.

To prevent cervical and other cancers, the CDC recommends all preteens complete HPV vaccination, starting ages 11-12.

Primary care and OBGYN providers offer routine screening for HPV that can detect irregularities before cancer develops, reducing the likelihood of severe disease.
