EARLY CHRISTIAN-BYZANTINE ART

What began in the catacombs developed into mosaics in which pagan subjects were assimilated and transformed for Christianity

Constantine moved the capital of the Roman Empire to Byzantium in 323, later called Constantinople, then Istanbul

The artists appropriated the Classical style and Roman Imperial imagery for Christian iconography

How did the Early Christian artist create a new visual language?

The Christians inherited the Roman use of Mosaics on the floors and walls

The Roman secular building was used for civic and judicial functions, the basilica was best used to adapt for Christian needs

San Vitale, a central plan church in Ravenna, used mosaics to disguise the architecture and create the illusion of another world

The use of gold in glass mosaics created a glittering and shimmering enclosure

Baptism of Christ surrounded by the Twelve Apostles

The entire dome of Galla Placidia is covered with mosaics of eight Apostles, including St. Lawrence

In the Eastern half of the Roman Empire, the Christians preferred the Central Plan

The Roman Basilica was Christianized by a transept which created a cross design

The twelve lambs symbolize the faithful and the twelve disciples

The Saint wears a purple tunic embroidered with bees, symbolizing eloquence, and raises his arms in an "orant" position.
