Most species (plant and animal) use playa resources for a relatively short period - whether resident or migratory; necessary to protect habitats so that ecological services can be provided elsewhere or in the future

Why Concerned? • Widespread and dramatic loss --60% of historical playas are gone, cultivated, or filled with sediment -Functional loss of remaining wetlands • 95.3% reduced ecological condition • ~90% vulnerable to loss by 2100 -Climate and land use change Lack of regulations or legal protection • Primary threat sedimentation

Failure of Conservation Efforts! One of the biggest hurdles to playa conservation is that we have been considering, planning, and managing playa wetlands at the wrong scale. The value of playa wetland is not at the individual level, but rather at the system level. Furthermore, effective conservation management must consider the role of system wide spatiotemporal dynamics to the persistence of this system..

A new approach to conservation of playas • Develop meaningful ecological objectives • Plan at larger spatial and temporal scales • Realize playas are different than all other wetlands

The Playa Wetland System • The spatial structure of the playa wetland system is characterized by physical patchiness -Consists of many patches of playa wetland nested within a matrix of upland The Playa Wetland System •Continuous transient dynamics characterize the system -Precipitation is the sole hydrologic input to the system - The presence of water is required for a playa to function Value of individual playas depends on scale of ecological processes • Some playas may be most important for fine-scale processes Others may be more important for broad

Percolation theory: Theoretical model for understanding the topological effect of removing nodes from a network - Extensively validated for different kinds of networks across scientific disciplines

Playa Wetland Prioritization • Damage process model ID playa wetlands with the greatest contribution to maintaining global connectivity when TPWN most vulnerable A • Weights of estimated differences in the magnitude of movement or flow assigned to each playa wetland as directed output link Weighted Dispersal Kernel Bivariate, exponential distance decay function - Accounts for potential dispersal pathways in all directions out of playa wetland k = distance parameter • w = volume parameter (e.g, habitat attributes)
