In alcuni popoli, specialmente asiatici, assumeva pratica quasi religiosa. Si osservi che quest'attività costituisce un mezzo valido per socializzare e per stare a contatto con la natura, in particolare nel tiro di campagna nelle sagome che simulano gli animali. Si mettono alla prova le proprie capacità in rapporto a sé stesso, le gare individuali con terzi non costituiscono rivalità assoluta, la concentrazione è prerogativa del bravo arciere che pratica il tiro in simbiosi dapprima con sé stesso. Il manuale può essere uno strumento di consultazione per tutti gli appassionati del tiro con l'arco, dagli arcieri principianti ai più esperti, consci che il manuale non esaurisce l'argomento, ma vorrebbe essere motivo di confronto fra persone che condividono uno stesso interesse.

Per emicrania si intende una sindrome caratterizzata da dolore localizzato in una metà della testa. E' una sindrome della quale rimane sconosciuta la causa. I sintomi considerati dal punto di vista osteopatico sono: distensione, trazione, dilatazione delle arterie intra ed extra craniche, trazione sui seni venosi intracranici e su alcune porzioni della dura madre; compressione, trazione, infiammazione dei nervi cranici V, IX, X, contratture. alterazioni della muscolatura cranio cervicale e a carico delle loro aponeurosi Il trattamento osteopatico è globale, considera i tessuti molli della struttura, le funzioni articolari, lo stato di tensione viscerale, il movimento cranico, utilizzando ciascuna tecnica al momento opportuno, qualora le premesse della sua esecuzione sono state accettate. Possibilità terapeutiche osteopatiche consistono nelle tecniche occipito-condilare, occipito-mastoidea, di compressione del IV ventricolo, di drenaggio di seni venosi cranici, tecnica del sacro, tecnica epatica, tecniche sul cuboide e sullo scafoide, tecnica di liberazione del diaframma toracico e di liberazione cranio-diaframmatica, tecniche sulla sfera cranica globale posteriore e sui tessuti molli della regione cervicale, tecnica prima costa.
