Horticulture: Intensive plant cultivation

Propagation: Creating more plants

Asexual propagation: Cuttings, division, etc Genetically identical

Polytunnel: Steel frame skinned with polyethylene film

Roll-up sides: For ventilation

Geotextile fabric: Groundcloth

Life cycle: Number of seasons the plant is expected to live

Hardiness: Tolerance to cold

Hardiness zones: Based on lowest average winter temps in area

Herbaceous: Doesn't form woody stems

Tree: Low number of "trunks"

Evergreen: Keeps leaves over winter

Plug tray For starting young plants

Dibble: Make a hole or indentation for planting seed or plug

Species: Naturally occurring

Hybrids Bred and selected for garden qualities

Etiolation: Stretching towards light

Hardening off: Acclimating young plants to new environment

Crown: Where the roots transition and join with the stem

Monoecious: Male and female flowers on the same plant

Root-bound: The roots have nowhere to go, so they circle the pot

Potting soil: AKA potting mix or soilless mix

IPM: Integrated pest management
