EU project procedures:- 7. Winners informed. Negotiation period starts. Key document is the DOW - Declaration of Work, a description that accompanies the contract between EC and lead institution. 8. Negotiations concluded, project starts with kick-off meeting. 9. Project evaluated at half-way and end points - does it conform to the specifications in the DOW? Has it delivered?

Collaboration can increase the power and range of research and apply more resources to a research problem. However, it requires careful management and much time is spent in negotiation.

Ma è proprio in questa fase di globalizzazione, foriera di tensioni per i territori, che le fondazioni, ad essi così strettamente legate, possono rinnovare il proprio ruolo e insieme contribuire al rilancio dello sviluppo locale: ascesa e declino di un territorio dipendono infatti dalla capacità di ridefinire la sua identità per adattarla e rispondere alle sfide esterne. La ricerca alla base del presente volume si è posta l'obiettivo di individuare e di sperimentare (attraverso un progetto che ha coinvolto un numero limitato ma rappresentativo di fondazioni) la strada più efficace per consolidare il ruolo di queste istituzioni nello sviluppo locale, ad esse affidato come obiettivo prioritario dalla legge. Cruciale risulta la responsabilizzazione della leadership a tutela degli interessi collettivi, accompagnata da una gestione selettiva e focalizzata delle risorse, all'interno però di una strategia di sviluppo che promuova la cooperazione tra i vari attori locali e trasformi il territorio, da «arena» in cui interagiscono diversi attori, in un vero e proprio «soggetto collettivo».

Più stato più mercato

Il rapporto tra storia e scienze sociali è la marca distintiva di «Meridiana». Per questa ragione abbiamo deciso di farne il tema centrale del numero 100 della rivista, nella convinzione tuttavia che esso stia acquisendo una nuova rilevanza, soprattutto se declinato in termini di interdisciplinarietà. Il fascicolo propone quindi un ricco itinerario di temi e problemi. Il percorso prende avvio con una riflessione sul rapporto tra natura e società, richiamando il dibattito sull'Antropocene e il dialogo con altre conoscenze disciplinari. In particolare sono messe a fuoco le relazioni tra scienze naturali e scienze sociali, sottolin-

eando la crescente necessità di assegnare a queste ultime un ruolo più centrale nelle questioni relative all'ambiente. In un altro contributo si mostra come le scienze sociali siano state meno «coraggiose» di quelle naturali, non riuscendo a cogliere e a prendere sul serio l'importanza delle scoperte della fisica quantistica. Da queste analisi emerge la preoccupazione di recuperare la dimensione applicativa del sapere delle scienze sociali, la loro capacità di presidiare il senso comune e di prendersi cura del reale. L'attenzione si sposta poi sul dibattito sull'eurocentrismo e la «provincializzazione dell'Europa». Il punto di vista storiografico è messo qui a confronto con la prospettiva degli studi postcoloniali, a una parte importante dei quali viene rimproverato un orientamento destoricizzato e decontestualizzato. Si evidenzia in questo caso un difetto di comunicazione e integrazione tra discipline diverse. Un esempio ben riuscito di pratica interdisciplinare riguarda invece lo studio dei processi di costruzione sociale del male, affrontato prendendo in esame le rappresentazioni simboliche tipizzate che alimentano l'immaginario sociale e si diffondono con successo nella sfera pubblica. Un'altra lettura interdisciplinare è relativa alla riscoperta del pensiero utopico da parte delle scienze sociali. L'utopia può essere un potente antidoto contro il «principio rassegnazione», evocando l'importanza del futuro come progetto individuale e collettivo. Viene poi problematizzata la crisi della democrazia, contestualizzando il ruolo politico dello Stato e la questione dei differenziali di potere tra governanti e governati. Spostandoci sul versante del funzionamento dell'economia, è proposta una critica dell'idea di homo economicus, soprattutto del fatto che gli economisti la difendano senza troppo curarsi dei danni sociali che produce. Successivamente l'attenzione è rivolta ai processi di mutamento sociale, indagati attraverso l'analisi dei reticoli sociali e gli strumenti messi a punto dalla microstoria e dalla storia orale. Un altro contributo si sofferma sull'approccio biografico, considerato come prospettiva teorica e metodologica per studiare il mutamento politico. E un altro ancora approfondisce la sociologia di Norbert Elias. Come rivelano nel complesso i saggi di questo numero, la ricerca interdisciplinare richiede capacità di apertura e di dialogo. Non si tratta di annullare i confini delle discipline, quanto di creare condizioni e possibilità che ne consentano un superamento o, quantomeno, un attraversamento, incentivando pratiche conoscitive orientate alla contaminazione dei saperi. È quello che da sempre cerca di fare «Meridiana».

I Populismi tra Economia e Politica

L'Istituto per la Ricostruzione Industriale (IRI) nasce nel 1933, per volere di Mussolini e su progetto di Alberto Beneduce, con l'intento di evitare il fallimento delle principali banche e imprese italiane e con esso il crollo dell'economia, già provata dalla crisi mondiale esplosa nel 1929. Dal dopoguerra l'Istituto è protagonista prima della ricostruzione e poi del miracolo economico. Dopo le difficoltà emerse negli anni '70 e il programma di ristrutturazione e rilancio degli anni '80, l'IRI conclude la sua attività nel 2002 dopo le operazioni di privatizzazione che contribuiscono in misura significativa al raggiungimento degli obiettivi di finanza pubblica e all'adesione italiana all'euro. Questo volume prende in esame l'intero arco della vita dell'IRI, dalle vicende di alcuni suoi settori di attività ai risultati di bilancio, dalle pratiche di programmazione e controllo al suo impatto sull'economia e sullo sviluppo del paese. L'IRI è stato il prodotto della sua storia, un Gruppo singolare: holding di imprese e strumento della politica economica, con un largo spettro di attività nell'industria e nei servizi. Nella prima parte di questo volume si considerano le vicende di alcuni fra i suoi principali settori: la siderurgia, dai grandi successi nei decenni della crescita alle crisi della seconda parte degli anni Settanta; le telecomunicazioni, dalla gestione di un monopolio tecnologico ai cambiamenti degli anni Ottanta e Novanta; i casi emblematici dell'Alfa Romeo, della navalmeccanica, della Finmare e dell'Alitalia. Nella seconda parte del volume si analizzano dati e risultati di bilancio dell'IRI e delle sue 'finanziarie'. Si ricostruisce l'evoluzione delle pratiche di controllo e programmazione dell'Istituto in relazione ai mutamenti nella politica economica nazionale. Nella terza parte si analizza il ruolo del Gruppo nell'economia italiana, quale risulta dalla matrice delle interdipendenze settoriali e come agente di diffusione di ricerca, conoscenza e sviluppo tecnologico. Chiude il volume un'ampia bibliografia sul Gruppo IRI.

Fondazioni e sviluppo locale

I suoi esponenti sedevano nel direttorio della Banca d'Inghilterra come nella Camera dei Lord, ricoprivano incarichi di governo e animavano la mondanità più esclusiva. Avevano soprattutto un'enorme coscienza di sé e della propria funzione, e una grande solidarietà di gruppo e di ceto. In questo libro si racconta l'ascesa di tale élite imperiale, capitalistica e aristocratica insieme, e se ne descrivono il profilo sociale e la cultura operativa. Si parte dalla scoperta della globalizzazione, sulla base di fonti anche letterarie e artistiche, si analizzano poi da una parte la diffusione di speculazione e gioco di Borsa e dall'altra la concentrazione in poche mani di un colossale potere economico e politico. Ciò fu possibile all'élite finanziaria perché, pur professando i principi di un'assoluta libertà economica, il suo liberismo era tutt'altro che espressione delle forze spontanee del mercato. I finanzieri internazionali si erano dati tacite ma stringenti regole comportamentali che delimitavano lo spazio tanto della concorrenza quanto della cooperazione. L'epoca in cui la globalizzazione si delineò non fu affatto un periodo di anarchia economica, bensì di regolazione dell'economia, sebbene su basi rigorosamente privatistiche. E forse è questa la differenza più profonda rispetto alla globalizzazione del nostro tempo, che ha sottratto la dinamica della finanza a ogni regola.

Storia del capitalismo italiano

Nelson Fausto The Greek myth of Prometheus with its picture of a vulture feasting on its chained victim has traditionally provided a visual image of liver regeneration. It is a powerful and frightening representation but if one were to substitute the vulture by a surgeon and Prometheus by a patient laying on a properly prepared operating table, the outcome of the procedure would not differ significantly from that described by Greek poets. Yet few of us who work in the field have stopped long enough to ask where this myth originated. Did the poet observe a case of liver regeneration in a human being? Was it brilliant intuition or perhaps, literally, just a 'gut feeling' of a poet looking for good rhymes that led to the prediction that livers grow when part of the tissue is removed? This book does not attempt to solve these historical issues. It does, instead, cover in detail some of the major modern themes of research on liver regeneration, injury and repair. As indicated in Dr. N. Bucher's chapter, the modern phase of experimental studies on liver regeneration started in 1931 with the publication by Higgins and Anderson of a method to perform a two-thirds resection of the liver of a rat. The technique described has 3 remarkable features: 1) it is highly reproducible, resulting in the removal of 68% of the liver, 2) it has minimal if any mortality, and 3) it consists only of blood vessel ligation and does not involve cutting through or wounding hepatic tissue.

È perché durante il XIX secolo il diritto privato si costituisce in una speciale relazione di opposizione e solidarietà con il diritto pubblico – dando così forma all'esperienza della politica che è ancora la nostra – che la sua estraneità alla dimensione della pluralità e del comune appare tanto evidente da parerci naturale. Ricostruire la storia dei processi giuridici che hanno dato all'aggettivo "privato" il senso che gli riconosciamo ancora oggi, vuol dire anche avanzare una nuova lettura del diritto privato, finalmente riconsegnato alla sua radice civile e cooperativa. La risposta che queste ricerche provano a suggerire che il carattere cooperativo del diritto privato – la sua formidabile capacità di istituire collettivi, di disciplinare rapporti cooperanti e di dare forma al molteplice – non è il frutto di una correzione, pietosa o moralistica, alla sua natura inderogabilmente patrimoniale e proprietaria. Al contrario, esso gli è stato sempre proprio e può finalmente tornare in piena luce una volta che il diritto privato si sia definitivamente emancipato dal ruolo di sparring partner del diritto pubblico. Difendendo la potenza istituyente e le virtù trasformative dell'astrazione giuridica, il libro propone quindi di leggere nel "diritto dei privati" – un diritto privato finalmente ri-civilizzato – lo spartito di una nuova politica.
