Ankyloblepharon: Adhesion between upper and lower eyelid margins.

Ablepharon: Absence of the eyelid.

Decreased dimensions of the palpebral fissure.

Drooping of the upper eyelid.

Distichiasis: The accessory row of eyelashes.

Trichiasis: Misdirected eyelashes.

Outward turning of the lid margin.

Entropion: Inward turning of the lid margin.

Telecanthus: Widely separated nose and eye (medial canthi).

Epicanthus: Extra fold of skin on medial side of the lower lid (palpebro-nasal fold).

Symblepharon: Adhesion between the palpebral and bulbar conjunctiva.

Lagophthalmos: Inability to close the eyelid completely.

Euryblepharon: Enlarged palpebral aperture.

Blepharospasm: Toric spasm of orbicularis oculi muscle.

Floppy eyelid syndrome: Floppy, easily eversible upper lid with papillary conjunctivitis at the upper tarsus.

Coloboma: Absence of some ocular tissue.
