Myelodysplastic syndromes (MDS) are the most common hematological malignancies involving mostly the elderly population. The major morbidity relates to patients' symptomatic cytopenias. MDS was previously named as "preleukemia" or "smoldering leukemia" as the lack of terminal cells in MDS and because about 25% of all cases progresses into acute myeloid leukemia. According to various reports the annual incidence of MDS ranges widely from 2-12 per 100.000, increasing to 30-50 cases per 100.000 among persons aged 70 or older. It is believed that the true incidence of MDS have been underestimated however it seems to be comparable to that for multiple myeloma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia. In the past decade much progress had been made; we know more on the disease pathology, there is more emphasis on the care and more targeted therapy had been invested. Authors provide updated knowledge in this book on all clinically important aspects of the disease. Hot topics of our days are discussed in chapters by outstanding and well known scientists from all over the world. TNM Classification of Malignant Tumours

Surgery for Ovarian Cancer

In Meeting Psychosocial Needs of Women with Breast Cancer, the National Cancer Policy Board of the Institute of Medicine examines the psychosocial consequences of the cancer experience. The fourth edition of the TNM Classification was published in 1987,¹ and a revision in 1992.² It was the result of efforts by all national TNM Committees towards a worldwide uniform classification. The classification criteria are identical with the fourth edition of the Manual for Staging of Cancer of the American Joint Committee on Cancer (AJCC). Although the classification has found wide acceptance, some workers have pointed out that individual definitions and rules for staging are not sufficiently detailed. This can lead to inconsistent application of the classification, the antithesis of standardization. This source of differences in interpretation applies not only to the classification of individual organs but also to the general rules of the system, especially to the definitions of the requirements for the pathological classification (pT, pN). These are specified only for carcinoma of the breast; for other sites, reference must be made back to the general rules, which can lead to variable interpretations. The TNM Project Committee of the UICC has addressed this problem and collected and considered the criticisms and suggestions from the national TNM Committees as well as from cancer registries, oncological associations and individual users. The result was the decision to complement the 4th edition of the TNM Classification 1.2.3 with the publication of a TNM Supplement containing recommendations for the uniform use of TNM.

Informatics and Medicine

International cooperation on the health of seafarers began many years ago. As early as 1921, an international convention regarding this matter was presented to governments of maritime countries for ratification. The First World Health Assembly, in 1948, recommended that WHO should establish, with the International Labour Office, a Joint Committee on the hygiene of seafarers. The first session of this Committee, held in 1949, defined the problems affecting the health of seamen and made a number of recommendations. In the opinion of this Joint Committee, the health of seamen called for international attention for a number of reasons. By the nature of his work, the seafarer is obliged to travel from country to country and is exposed to great variations of climate and also to any disease that may be prevalent in the port of call. He may therefore become a carrier of disease, so that the protection of his health is of importance not only to himself and the other members of the crew but also to the populations of other countries he visits. Yet, on account of the nature of his employment, it is difficult to provide the seafarer with the same standard of health care that is generally available to other sections of the population.
