Some of their conclusions are distinctly fundamentalist, but Jenkins finds an intriguing paradox, for they are also finding ideas in the Bible that are socially liberating, especially with respect to women's rights. Across Africa, Asia, and Latin America, such Christians are social activists in the forefront of a wide range of liberation movements. It's hard to overstate how interesting, how eye-opening, how frequently surprising (and sometimes disturbing) Jenkins' findings are. Anyone interested in the implications of these trends for the major denominations, for Muslim-Christian conflict, and for global politics will find *The New Faces of Christianity* provocative and incisive--and indispensable.

New Hymn and Tune Book

This book explores the idea of Anglican identity through a study of major figures from Richard Hooker to Michael Ramsey, focusing on their contribution to contemporary thinking about Christian spirituality, worship, mission. Theology and ministry.

Hymns, Psalms, & Spiritual Songs, Pulpit Edition

This is a major revision of *The Anglican Use Gradual*, 2007 which follows the structure of the *Graduale Romanum* and draws upon the musicological work of Dr. Palmer (G.H.P.), Francis Burgess (F.B.), and Winfred Douglas (W.D.). Since *The Plainchant Gradual* of Palmer and Burgess is again available in a reprint, I have eliminated most of the occasional melismatic chants and have included simple psalm tone chants based on Burgess' *The English Gradual* in order to provide a practical book that can be used in most churches. This expanded volume follows the structure and text of *Divine Worship: The Missal*, 2015, and covers all of the minor propers called for in that Missal. An index is included to adapt this book to the Ordinary Time lectionary sequence.
