In 1815 I got married to Sallie Waters

and the family and I moved to Indian Territory

and there I started again working on the syllabary.

These are the sounds of the Cherokee language.

The first one to read was my daughter Ayoka.

It wasn't long after that a type and press was created.

In 1824 I brought it east and gave it to the Cherokee people.

In 1824 I received a silver medal.

Two hundred years later the Cherokee syllabary is still bringing our people together.
